Value Proposition for Current Faculty

When you join CAMLS as an affiliated faculty, you will have the following benefits:

* Flexible funds offered under 1.1, 2, and 3 are to be used for academic purposes, such as summer salary, graduate student funds, travel, conference registration, or lab supplies.

1. INDUSTRY MEMBER RECRUITMENT

1.1 Industry Member: Recruit an industry member and receive flexible funds

<i>Industry Membership Level (2 yr)</i>	<i>You receive (one time)</i>
Advantage Level \$110,000	\$1,000
Full Level \$62,000	\$750
Associate Level \$33,000	\$500

1.2 Through Industry Membership, you will have R&D funds for industry-centric projects

<i>Industry Membership Level (2 yr)</i>	<i>Your R&D Funds (2 yr)</i>
Advantage Level \$110,000	\$74,000
Full Level \$62,000	\$43,000
Associate Level \$33,000	\$23,500

2. TRAINING

Faculty members use expertise to deliver short courses, workshops, or any type of training for internal (UTSA) or external audiences for fee and receive 90% of the profit (revenue minus expenses) as flexible funds. CAMLS holds 10% of the profit for facilitating marketing and enrollments.

3. PROPOSALS: Grants and Contracts

Incentives for PI's:

- PI of each awarded proposal submitted through CAMLS receives \$500
- PI of each awarded large scale proposal ($\geq \$1M$) through CAMLS receives \$1,000
- PI who submitted 3 or more proposals per FY through CAMLS receives \$500
